
Management Policies and Procedures

Purpose of modules

The Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, stipulates that all employers, so far as is reasonably practicable, must ensure the health, safety and welfare of their service users, employees, contracted staff and anyone who may visit their premises or be affected by its activities.

Modules

Every organisation should appoint someone with overall authority and responsibility for electrical systems on the premises. That person has a duty to prepare and issue a general policy statement on health and safety at work, including the organisation and arrangements for carrying out that policy.

The Electricity at Work Regulations 1989, places duties on directors, managers, and heads of services to ensure that all electrical services and equipment is maintained to prevent danger and that only Competent Persons are permitted to work with, maintain or repair such equipment.
